This collaborative project initiated in 2018 in the first week of February, at NIV Art Gallery, New Delhi, with a group of five artists- Sonam Chaturvedi, Tatjana Henderieckx, Charlot Van Geert, Priyesh Gothwal and Priyank Gothwal (to know more, refer to this <u>article</u>).

Each artist showed their preliminary drafts that they aim to develop further. This exercise, of showing drafts, gave us the scope to play around and create a space for dialogue, critique and dissemination. The nature of *first draft* is to keep mutating and remain in flux; it retains a porosity which not only absorbs but also sheds its own definitions with every step. What remains is the porosity itself, which comes through a transient temporality of a pop-up, a draft, with the status of being always inprogress.











The project's second iteration took place on 13th of July at a residential place (terrace) in Vasantkunj, with Neeraj Patel, Suvani Suri, Priyank Gothwal, Priyesh Gothwal, Divya Singh and Sonam. It followed the same intent as the first one, with a separate group of artists but displaying in a residential space, that created a different dynamic.

first draft ings --

The initiative has now evolved into a space of gatherings, called *first draft-ings*, where we meet in small groups at informal spaces in New Delhi, India. These gatherings have provided a niche for people from all fields to connect and share, involving performers (dancers, musicians, theatre practitioners etc), researchers, sound/visual-designers, engineers/makers, educators, and others. It offers an offline space to come together, share, eat, drink, chat, play, rest, recuperate and perhaps create (/not) around a pre-decided collective prompt. Can we reimagine/ question/ provoke new forms of art making and its dissemination through these acts of coming together? Is it possible to generate spaces for slow-gatherings, whereby we do not necessarily create, yet reflect over the conversations that sprout into more connections, extensions, and leave/take forward its' residues? During these gatherings, we also attempt to touch upon the questions of intimacy through transmission: as a way to traverse the alternative nature of gatherings through proximity, collaboration, improvisation, slowness, rest, thus partaking in the intimate act(s) oftransmission.

The gatherings were around specific prompts including but not limited to -- the actions of storytelling, compassionate listening, walking, watching films, playing games, gifting, sleeping/snoozing, laughing and more.









This gathering invited people to share a page of their choice. It can be from a book, diary, notebook, letters, magazine, catalogue, album, to-dos, webpages, and others.
